Alex Landback called the first collective bargaining meeting to order at 3:22 pm.

Alex noted that, pursuant to CBA Article 26, the current CBA expires on August 31, 2021. Accordingly, renegotiations for a successor agreement shall begin no later than October 1, 2020. This meeting satisfies that requirement under Article 26.

FPU-BOT proposed a revised set of ground rules for negotiations (FPU-BOT “A”), adapted from the original ground rules implemented during the first CBA negotiations.

FPU-BOT then proposed the first 3 articles from the CBA: Preamble, Recognition, and Consultation. (FPU-BOT “B” through “D”).

Preamble (FPU-BOT “B”) and Recognition (FPU-BOT “C”) were tentatively approved by both UFF and FPU-BOT.

The following proposals will be discussed at the next meeting:

1. 2021-2024 Collective Bargaining Ground Rules (FPU-BOT “A”)
2. Article 2, Consultation (FPU-BOT “D”)
