A. APPLICABILITY/ACCOUNTABILITY: This policy applies to all University property and all members of the University community including visitors, students, faculty and employees. The University is committed to the safety of its students, employees and visitors. The University limits activities in campus waterways because the water depth varies from a shallow depth of 3.5 feet to 7 to 10 feet with steep drop offs in some areas. In addition, the water may contain wildlife, including alligators and snakes.

B. POLICY STATEMENT: No boating, swimming, diving, fishing or wading is pelmitted in the campus waterways without the prior written approval of the President or designee for safety reasons. The University community should be alert when enjoying the outdoor areas of our campus.
